

What is our current state of delivering care in Skilled Nursing facilities?

- Based on institutional care (i.e. hospitals)
- Staff centered care delivery
- Traditional nursing home staffing hierarchy
- Rotating staff

What is delivery of care in a Green/Small House?

- Major culture change
- Resident centered care delivery
- Universal care givers resulting in higher direct care staffing ratios
- Consistent staffing relationship based caregiving

Green/Small House – Operational Differences

- Change in hierarchy
- Staff training
- Delivery of care is based on each home


Additional Benefits

- **▲** Better clinical outcomes
- ▲ Faster response to change in resident conditions resulting in decreased re-hospitalization
- **▲** Promotes chronic disease management
- **▲** Decrease in turnover






Texas State Veterans Home Site Plan – Tyler, TX










Typical Resident Room



Green/Small House – Community Based Nursing Home

- Emphasis on small settings
- Mirrors ICF clients (1990) moving from large institution to smaller group homes (6 bedrooms or less)
 - -Recognized need for higher reimbursement which was designated as experimental class

Cost Savings

- Reduced hospitalization
- Reduced medication usage
- Higher salaries for employees less Medicaid dependency

How to Get Started

- Follow ICF precedence from 1990
- Approve pilot project for incremental reimbursement (i.e., add on specific)
- Specific rate tied to outcomes
