Dear Senator Shapiro and Members of the Committee,

The Texas Association of School Boards (TASB) solicited feedback from districts across the state about how they are using their high school allotment funds. Districts were asked the following questions:

- (a) Which programs will your district fund with the high school allotment?
- (b) Indicate whether each program is "Existing" or "New" and the grade levels served.

The attached spreadsheet contains responses we received from the 71 responding districts across the state.

As you are aware, the Legislature provided districts flexibility to use the funds to meet the needs of their students. School districts are sincerely grateful for that flexibility, and as the spreadsheet illustrates, districts are using the high school allotment in various and innovative ways. There is no pattern in the use of those funds across districts of similar size or geographic location (i.e., urban, suburban, rural). However, the following trends do emerge in this data set:

 The largest number of respondents are using the high school allotment to pay for dual credit, college tuition and textbooks, distance learning opportunities, Career and Technology courses, and college entrance exam fees (i.e., including SAT/ACT exams and THEA).

- Districts are also using the funds to provide Advanced Placement (AP), Pre-AP, and Gifted and Talented programs.
- Other uses for the funds include: hiring counselors, math and science teachers and providing career counseling, transition services, and professional development for teachers.

Districts are using the funds to pay for new and existing programs almost in equal proportion. While few respondents specified the grade levels served by their programs, those that did noted that the funds are being used to assist students in 9th grade and higher.

To provide further context for these responses, the second attached spreadsheet shows the total amount of the High School Allotment received by each of the districts that responded to TASB's questionnaire. Of the responding districts:

- Two districts received no High School Allotment because they serve grades K-8,
- Northside ISD received the largest allotment \$6,116,578, and
- The median allotment for the 2007-08 school year is \$154,182.

I hope this information provides a useful snapshot of how districts have made good use of the High School Allotment funds. As always, districts would greatly appreciate an increase in the High School Allotment to meet the increasing needs of their students in light of the evolving accountability and college readiness standards.
