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DARS Vision and Mission

Vision

A Texas where people with disabilities and families with children who have developmental delays enjoy the same opportunities as other Texans to pursue independent and productive lives.

Mission

To work in partnership with Texans with disabilities and families with children who have developmental delays to improve the quality of their lives and to enable their full participation in society.



Early Childhood Intervention Services (ECI)

- ECI is a coordinated system of services for children, birth to 36 months, with disabilities or delays in development.
- ECI services are available in every Texas county and are provided by a network of 56 local ECI program contractors.
- ECI is funded in part through IDEA Part C
- Total served: 57,110 (FY09)



Early Childhood Intervention Services (ECI)

- Reasons for eligibility:
 - Developmental delay 73%
 - Atypical development 16%
 - Medical diagnosis 11%
- Home and community based services
 - Physical, occupational, speech, and developmental therapy
 - Integrated into family routines
- Coordinate with other community programs

DARS Autism Program

- Provides services for children ages 3 through 8 with an autism spectrum disorder diagnoses
- Services provided by six contractors
 - Fort Worth, Dallas, Houston, Rosenberg, Austin, San Antonio
- Total served: 277 (FY09)
- Funding: FY 08-09 \$5M FY 10-11 \$6.6M



DARS Autism Program

- Program designed to:
 - Provide positive behavior support strategies, including Applied Behavioral Analysis (ABA)
 - ABA: a methodology used to treat a variety of disorders with a focus on decreasing problematic behaviors and teaching new skills
 - Other services provided include: assessments, testing, physical & occupational therapy
 - Compliment services included in a child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP), if such a plan exists



DARS Autism Program

- Bill private insurance and any other available third party source before using DARS funding
- Best practices/program improvements
 - Uniform insurance billing procedures
 - Maximum duration of services
 - Family Cost Share
 - Standardized progress assessments
