WHO: Senator Borris L. Miles

WHAT: Senator Borris L. Miles is hosting a Job Fair in communities with high

unemployment rates. According to the 2011-2015 ACS, US Census Bureau, Kashmere Gardens, Trinity Gardens, Fifth Ward, East Houston, Settegast, and East Little York/Homestead are in the top 15 neighborhoods with highest

rates of unemployment in the City of Houston.

The event will also include a Job Skills Workshop at 9AM for participants to learn how to write or revise a resume, interview and network, or use their job skills and experience in a new and different way. The Job Fair will begin at 10am with more

than 60 employers looking to fill positions.
