Sen. Donna Campbell Supports Senate Declaration of Border Crisis

Chair of Veteran Affairs and Border Security Votes in Favor of SR 535

AUSTIN – State Senator Donna Campbell, Chair of the Veteran Affairs and Border Security Committee, voted in support of SR 535 today declaring the crisis at the Texas-Mexico Border an emergency and calling upon Congress to pass a budget that funds resources to secure the border.

"The situation at the border is dire and will only get worse with inaction. Last week alone there were over 12,000 illegal crossings at the southern border, the highest number in over a decade. Our law enforcement is stretched thin and criminals including drug and human traffickers are attempting to exploit the situation. Congress must act to resolve this humanitarian crisis. Passage of today's resolution sends a message to Washington that Texans support every effort to enforce our laws, defend our sovereignty, and keep families safe along the border."- Senator Donna Campbell, M.D.
