Senator José Menéndez Issues Statement on SCOTUS Ruling to Aid Religious Schools

San Antonio, Texas -"The United States Supreme Court ruling in the case Espinosa v.

Montana Department of Revenue is a devastating hit to the cause of educational equity and accountability. It is troubling that at a time when we need to heal as one people, the highest court in our nation, decided to reinforce the disparities in our country's schools by allowing our tax dollars to subsidize private education."
